## Primary Colors

A group of colors from which all other colors can be obtained by mixing. RED, BLUE, and YELLOW.



RED




BLUE

Colors Intensity = The strength of a color.

Yellow      Orange      Green      Blue      Red      Purple  
Weak  $\longrightarrow$  Strong



**The amount of each paint is different because of the strength of the color = INTENSITY.**

To make **SECONDARY** colors we are going to mix our **PRIMARY**  
A color resulting from the mixing of two primary colors. GREEN, ORANGE, and PURPLE.



Blue + Yellow =

**GREEN**



Red + Yellow =

**ORANGE**



Red + Blue =

**PURPLE**

## Tertiary Colors

Tertiary colors are combinations of primary and secondary colours. There are six tertiary colors; red-orange, yellow-orange, yellow-green, blue-green, blue-violet, and red-violet.

# Complimentary - Colors directly across on the color wheel.




## Mixing Complimentary Colors - Neutral Browns

On your mixing tray mix equal parts of RED and GREEN




Neutral Brown

On your mixing tray mix LESS BLUE into ORANGE

On your mixing tray mix VERY LITTLE PURPLE and a lot of YELLOW

# Tints and Shades

**Tint** = A color + White

**Shade** = A color + Black

Tints and Shades are used to change the VALUE (the lightness or darkness of a color.)

Tints and Shades also change the INTENSITY of a color (The strength) or the (Purity - Color without a tint or shade would be the most intense)

**Step 1**

On your paint palette take out 4 big scoops of WHITE paint into a new cell.

Red Tint

Pure White →

**Step 2**

In the 4 scoops of white that was just separated out, ADD ONE SMALL DOT OF RED. This will create a very light pink

In the light pink that was just created, add another dot of RED. The pink will get a bit darker.

Add another dot of RED to make the color a bit darker.

**Step 1**

On your paint palette take out 4 big scoops of RED paint into a new cell.

Red Shade

← Pure red

**Step 2**

In the 4 scoops of RED that was just separated out, ADD ONE SMALL DOT OF BLACK. This will create a cherry RED

In the cherry red that was just created, add another dot of black. The cherry red will get a bit darker.

Add another dot of BLACK to make the color a bit darker.

Pure black

The Value is gradually getting darker.
