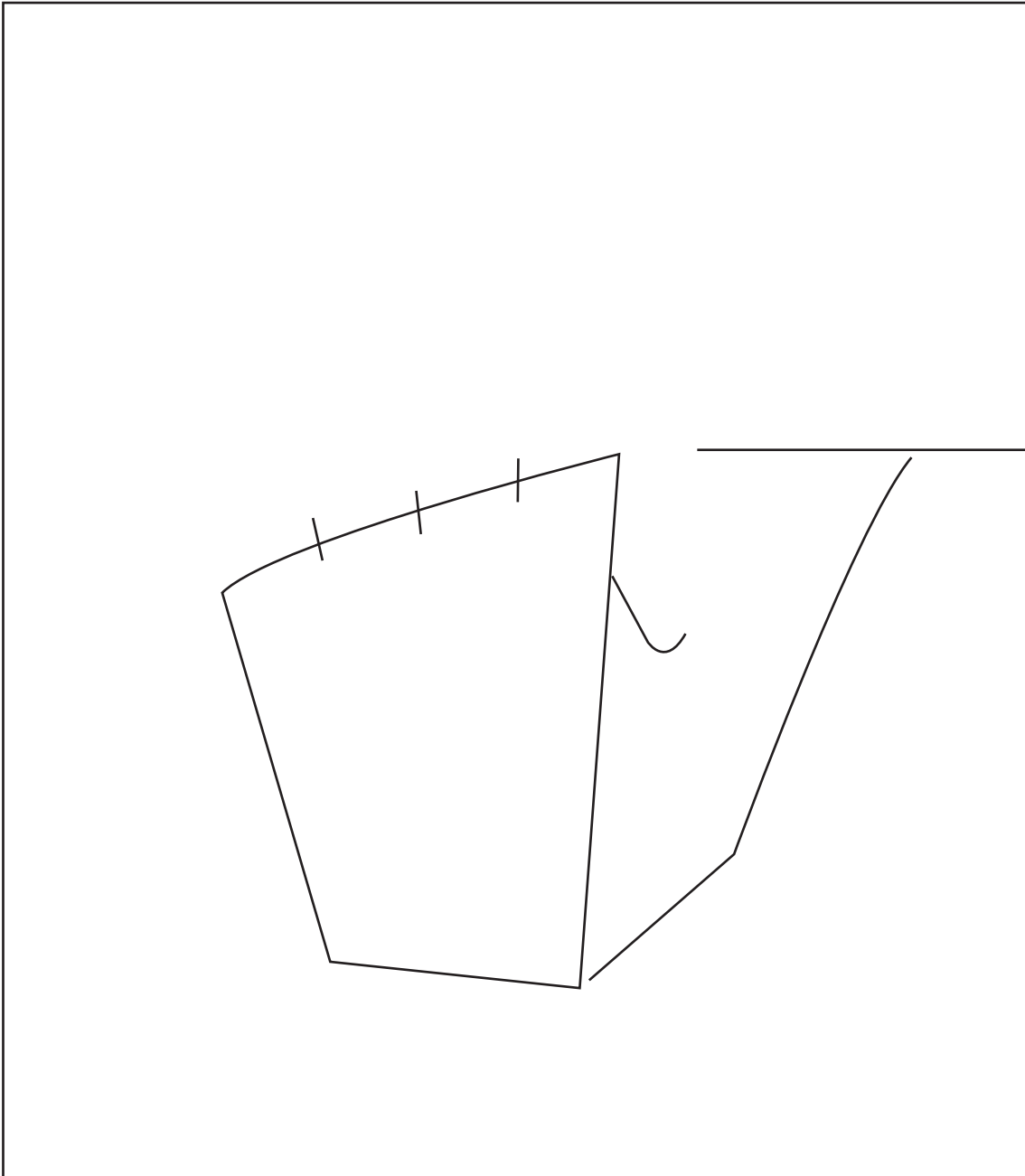
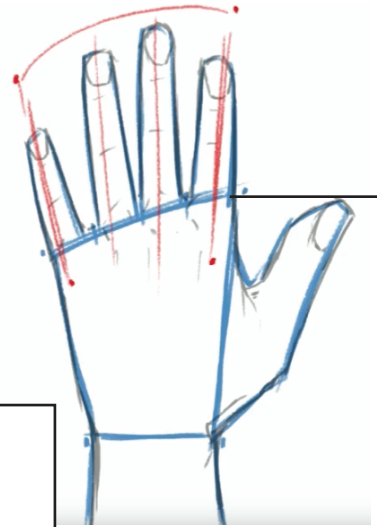


# How to draw a hand waving "Hi"

**The top of the thumb should be as high as the top of the pointed rectangle shape. i.e. (id est - in other words) the base of the pointer finger.**

**Step 1** - Draw the rectangle shape (for the palm) that has a high corner near the thumb.

**Step 2** - Divide the top into 4 equal parts for the fingers.

**Step 3** - Establish the thumb. Two angled lines that begin at the wrist.

**Step 4** - Use light lines to establish the direction of the outside fingers. Remember, there is a slight angle to the pinky and the pointer finger. See example.

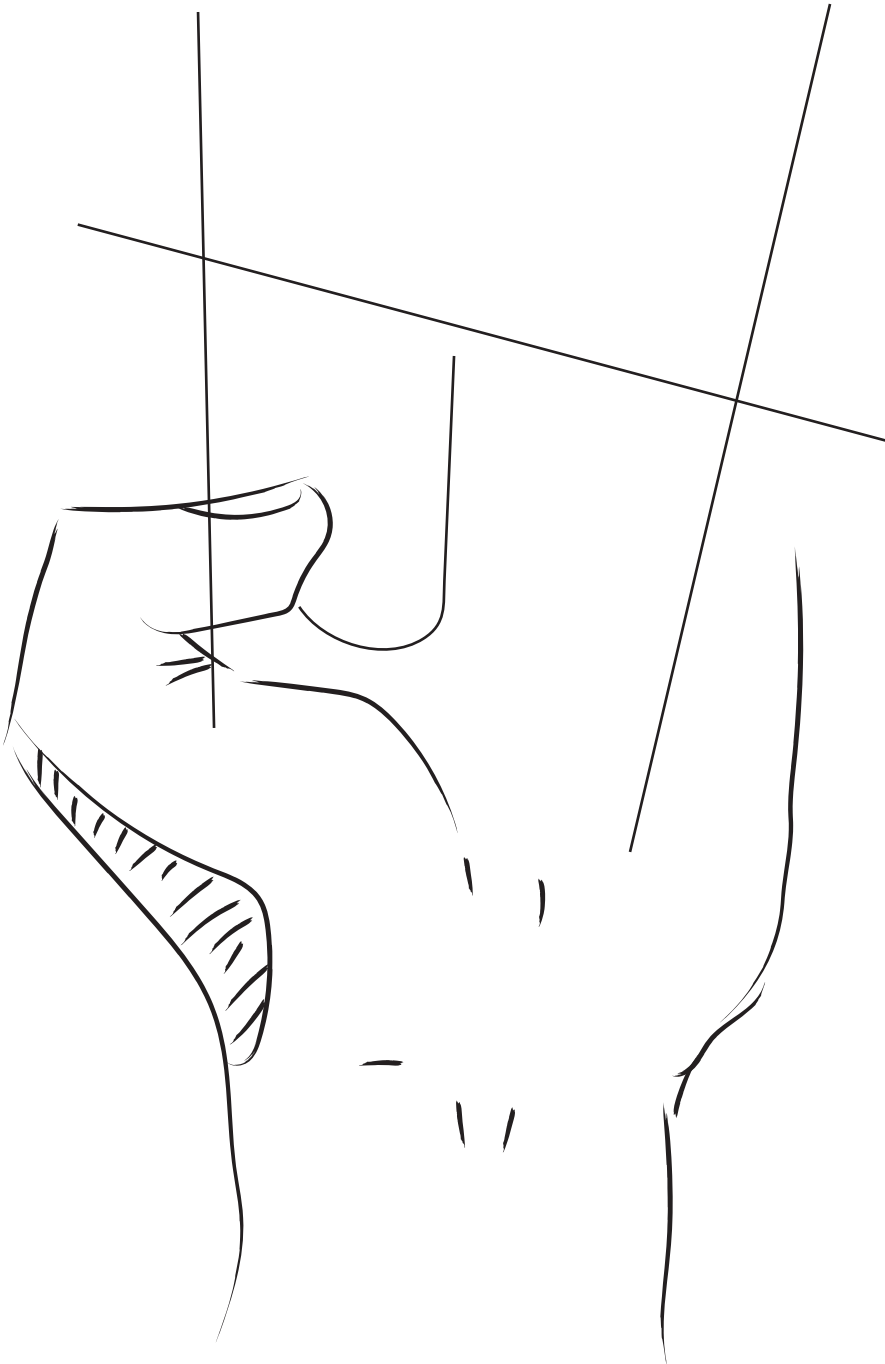
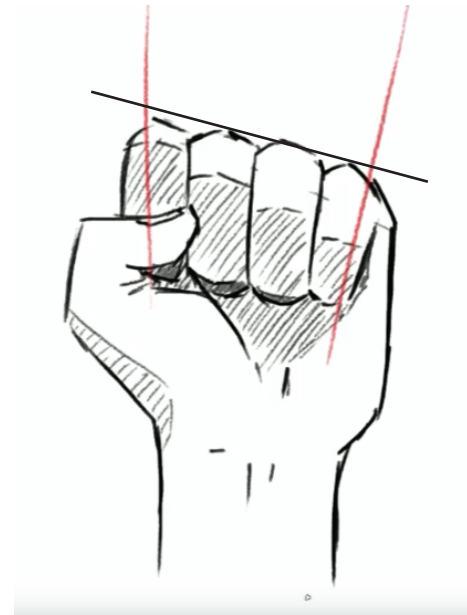
**Step 5** - Pay attention to the length of each finger. The pinky is the shortest, the ring finger is the second tallest, the middle is the longest and the pointer is shorter than the ring. Sometimes it is helpful to taper the width of the fingers as they get longer.

# Draw a fist



### Helpful tips -

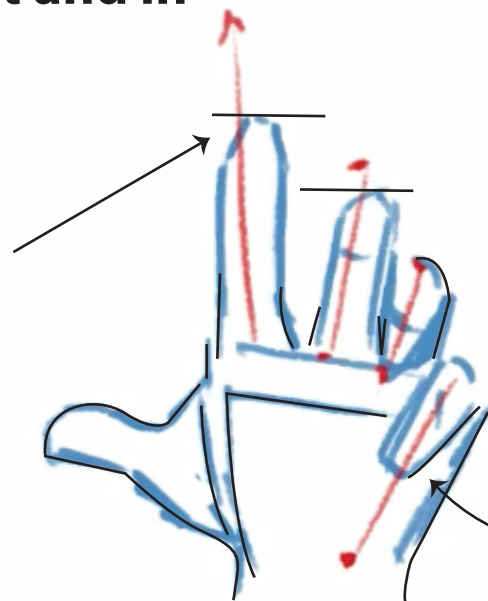
A closed hand will have the fingers pointing in toward the center of the hand.

The pinky and the pointer are angled in toward the center of the palm.

# Be aware of the angle of the fingers as they go out and in

Fingers spreading out have an angle out. The fingers are rarely straight off the palm.

The middle finger is the only finger that could be straight off the palm.



Fingers folding in have an angle in toward the center of the palm. e.g. (exempli gratia - for example) the pinky

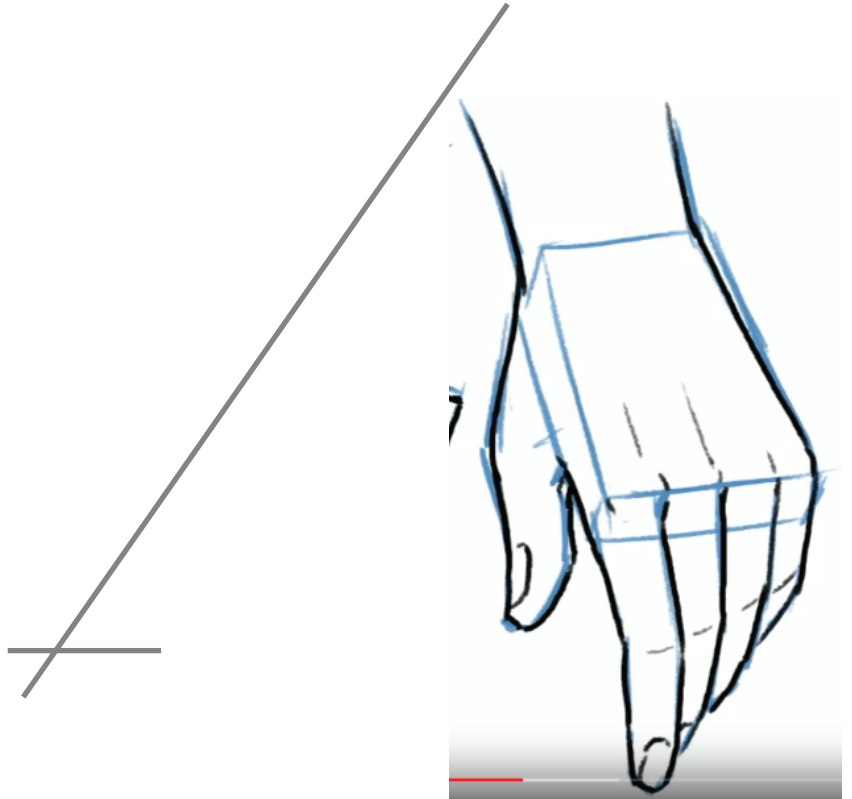
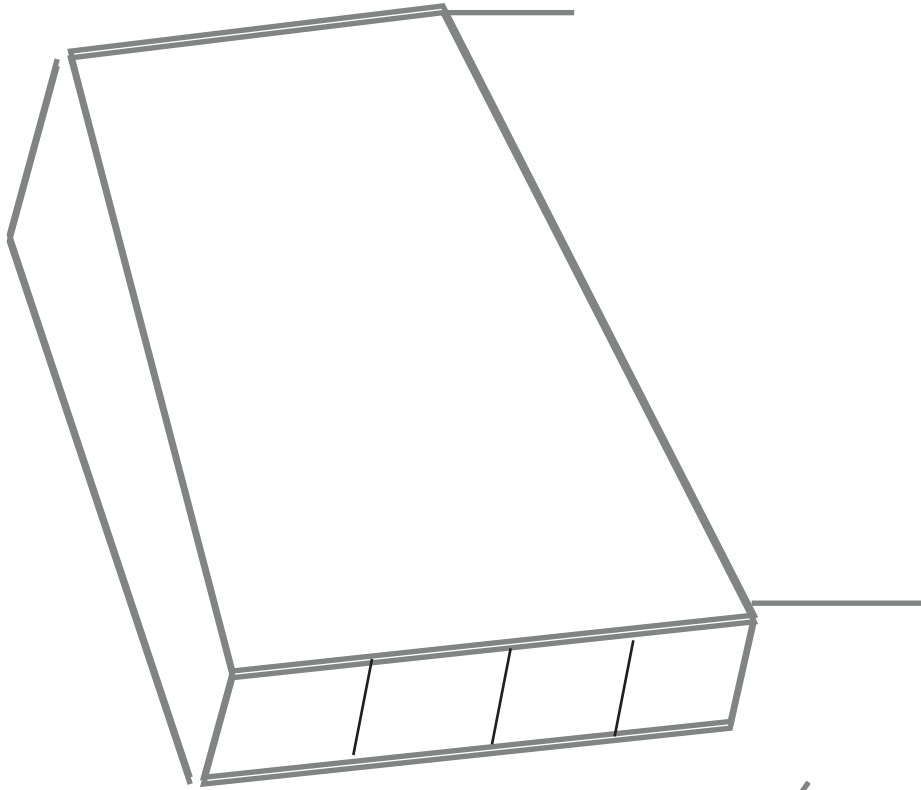


# Fingers have flat tops and bumpy bottoms

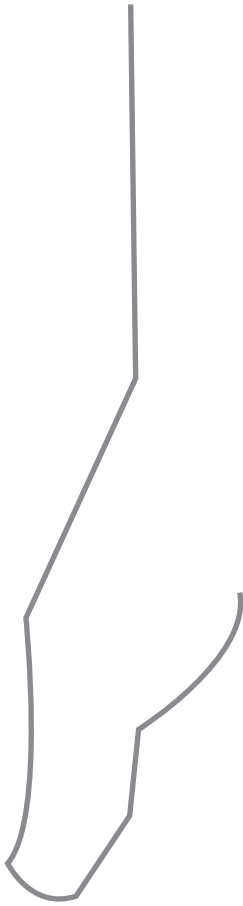
Fingers also have
