The pinky and the pointer are angled in toward the center of the palm.



Be aware of the angle of the fingers as they go out and in


Fingers spreading out have an angle out. The fingers are rarely straight off the palm.

The middle finger is the only finger that could be straight off the palm.





Fingers folding in have an angle in toward the center of the palm. e.g. (exempli gratia - for example) the pinky

Fingers also have 3 sections.









