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LINE

Line is an element of art. The elements of art are the basic building box that artists use to create, talk, and write about art. A full list of the elements of art are 1. Shape 2. Line 3. Color 4. Value 5. Space 6. Texture 7. Form. There are also Principles of art which we will discuss later.

Line is a visual shorthand, a way for artists to communicate five ideas.


1. To show the edge of an object. (Contour)

- 2. Line can describe the shape of the surface. (FORM)
- 3. To show where two object meet in space.
- 4. To show the path of an object, from point A to point B.


5. Line as texture.


A line has a beginning and an end.

Contour line - **A line that shows the edge of an object.** There is no shading/value in contour line drawings. Recreate the contour line drawing of the fruit.



Tip - Use the dot-to-dot technique to help you get accurate proportions.





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
Line can describe the shape of a surface.


Create rainbow type, up-and-over, lines to represent a bubbled or rounded surface.

Tip #1 - Keep your lines close together.


Tip #2 - Your lines must start and stop on a dot.

Fill the entire box with line as Form







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Use line as Form to represent the shape of each surface.

Use line as form to recreate the drawing.






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Line Quality is allowing your lines to have a variety of different thicknesses or textures.




