Required pieces:

Menu/Navigation:

-The color of the navigation buttons is easy to see. There is good contrast.

-The background of the Header of the website has a color, gradient, or pattern to emphasis the page buttons.

-There is evidence that the navigation was altered via the options available as custom designs. For example colors, animations, transparencies, and text color have been changed.

-The navigation is in the header. The navigation for the site can be seen on all the pages.

Home page:

-The Home page has text to introduce who made the site, and the content being presented.

-The Home page has an example of your digital art work.

-The Home page has color or pattern added to the background.

-The page has a background color, gradient, or pattern.
