## Pop Art Portrait - Rubric

3 pts.
There is evidence of a few errors in setting up the document. The colored boxes are the wrong size or the image has no contrast or each portrait is not separated out in layers i.e. hair, skin, eyes, mouth, and accents.

The projects provides evidence that the student repeated or copied some painted layers.

5 pts.
The projects provides evidence that the student was able to set up the document correctly. The colored boxes are $5.5^{\prime \prime}$ sq., the image has a high contrast, each portrait is separated out in layers i.e. hair, skin, eyes, mouth, and accents.

The projects provides evidence that the student was able to paint each individual layer for all 6 portraits. There are no repeated or copied painted layers.

The projects provides evidence that the student was able to adjust the color to create a Pop Art feel on each portrait. Colors were adjusted via layer modes, Hue and Saturation, opacity, etc.

The projects provides evidence that the student was creative with how the image was accented. Thoughtful designs or interesting ideas were added over and around each image.
