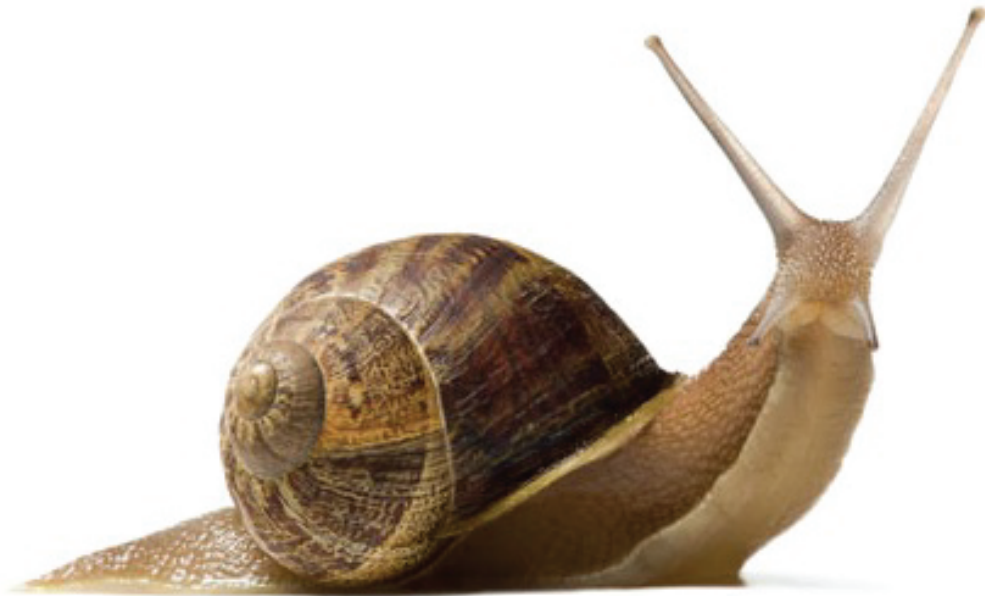


Found

The mythical beast and I have grown accustomed to the finer things in life and he may find it difficult to return the squalor of hanging out on the bottom of planter boxes.

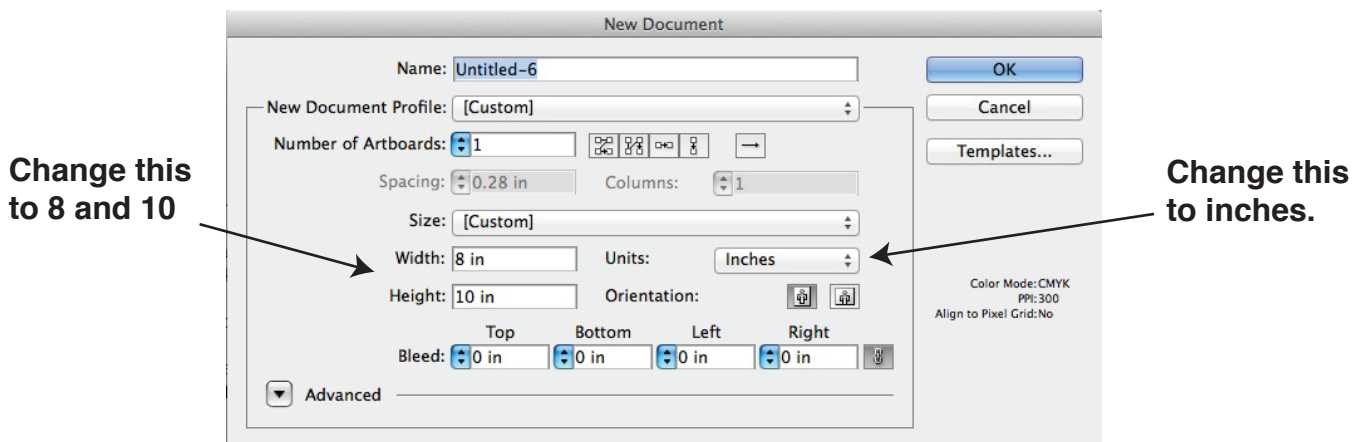
Lost or Found

Step 1: Look for an image of an object that you want to feature in your Lost / Found sign. This project should have an absurd, funny, quirky, or strange theme.

Tips to help you get ideas: Use necessary adjectives (describing words) to describe your object. Mislabel your object, for example if your object is a cat, call it a dog.

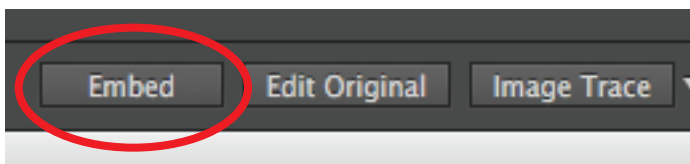
Step 2: Click on your image and RIGHT Click to > Copy Image.

Step 3: Open a new file in Adobe Illustrator. The screen that pops up when you open a new file is where you need to set the size of the document. Our document needs to be **8 inches x 10 inches.**

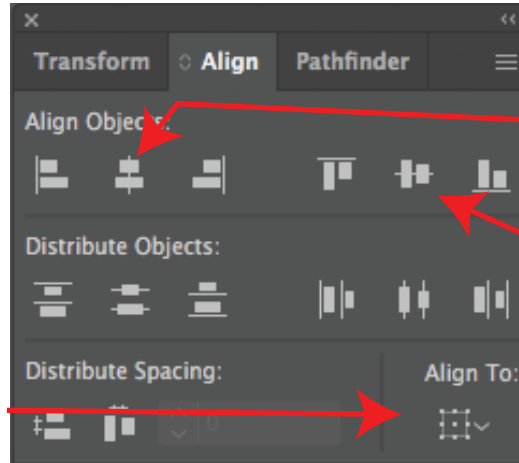


Step 4: Edit > Paste. If your image is really big you may need to zoom out (CNTRL and -) to grab the corners and scale the image down. (CNTRL and 0) to center your screen again.

Step 5: Embed image. At the top of your screen press the EMBED button or go to Window > Links > (in the small menu in the upper right corner) Embed link.



Step 6: Once your image is the correct size, select it and go to Window > Align



Step A: Change this to Align with the Artboard

Center Vertical

Center Horizontal

Step 7: Create a HeadLine. This will be the words at the top of the sign. For example, LOST DOG.

in the Window > Type > Character palette - Change the **Font** (*The name of the style the words*) to something that relates to the message of your sign. Change the size so the headline is larger than all the other type.

Step 8: Select the type tool from the tool bar.



Next you are going to add the body text. **Drag a marquee (box) the width and height of the block of type that you plan to add.**

The body text will have fun or strange qualities that our object may have. The body type should be around 1 paragraph long. For example, The Mythical Beast has was last seen leaving his job at the food court, etc, etc.

Typing in a marquee is nice because when you get to the end of a line the type will automatically descend to the next level.

Step 9: Use the type tool to reselect the type you just entered. Make the Type a between 14 - 21 pt. tall. Each project will be a bit different depending on how much you type.

Step 10: I am open to alternative layout solutions as long as you have a headline and some other type in your project. Feel free to explore and make a project that you are excited for people to see.

Step 11: Create a Pattern Brush to create a border all around your sign.

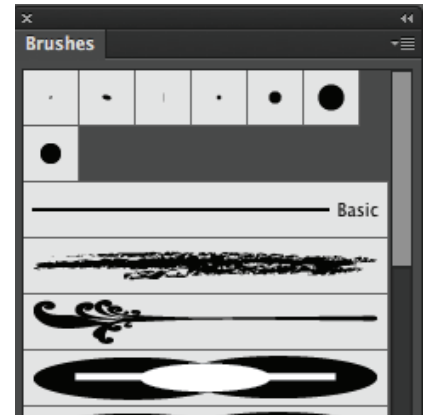
- How to create a Pattern Brush -

A. Create a **small** collection of shapes. Do not copy these examples, you must create your own border idea.



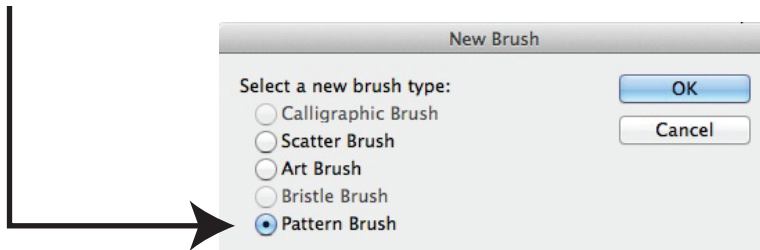
B. Object > group your shapes together.

C. Window > Brushes

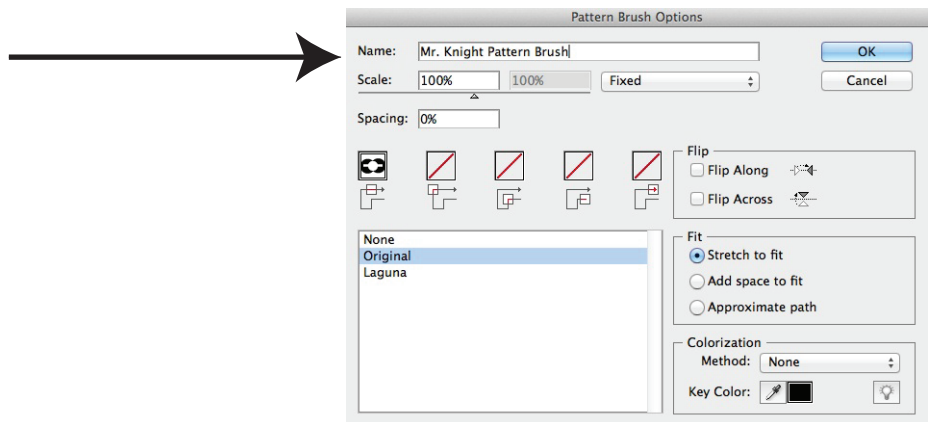


D. Drag your grouped shapes into the brush palette.

E. This menu will pop up - Choose > Pattern Brush



F. Name your pattern and click OK.



G. Create a STROKE with the Pen Tool or the Shape Tool.
For example.

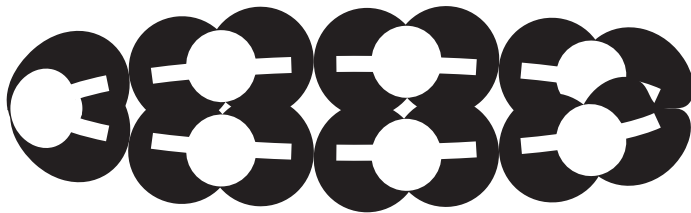


H. With the Stroke selected click on your brush design in the brush palette.
The brush option will be applied to the stroke.



I. You may need to adjust the weight of the Stroke. You can adjust the weight at the top of your screen next to the label “stroke” or Window > Stroke (this will open a palette)

Adjust the weight between .25 pt and 2 pt.

J. Draw a box around your Lost or Found design. With the box selected apply the brush pattern by clicking on the pattern in the brush menu. Window > Brushes

How to get the best grade -

1. Use as many tool as your can to improve your design.
2. Don't settle for your first idea. Push your ideas to the next step.
3. Modify or add to thing that are premade.
4. Redraw things that your find on the internet.
5. Make several lost or found signs.
6. Help the people around your seat.
7. Think of alternative formats that a lost or found sign might be in.
8. Have an interesting background. i.e. textures, or transparency effects.
9. Be creative!
